Dear Dighton-Rehoboth Families,

We would like to inform you that beginning on Tuesday, March 24th, the DRRSD Extended Learning website will be updated to include webpages from our professional staff. The staff webpages will include resources, announcements, and/or links updated by teachers and staff specifically related to classroom content. This may include access to Google Classroom, announcements and information, as well as directives from teachers on how to extend learning within their specific content areas.

The staff webpages can be accessed without a DR Regional account. We encourage both students and families to access these pages. Some teacher resources, however, including Google Classroom, may require students to sign into their DR Regional account. More information regarding Google Classroom can be found [here](#). Because distance learning is new to both students and staff, we anticipate some glitches and setbacks. We ask for patience and cooperation as we work to navigate this new platform and provide supplemental virtual instruction.

At this time, guidance from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) suggests that extended learning is enrichment and opportunities for continued learning. Due to this guidance from DESE, we have suggested that our professional staff utilize supplemental activities from curriculum resources to give students opportunities to practice within standards.

Accordingly, up to the anticipated return to school date of Tuesday, April 7th, we are not using extended learning to grade students based on DESE guidance. Should this guidance from DESE change, we will inform you immediately.

In summary, our extended learning opportunities continue to grow and we encourage families and students to access our resources daily. If you have questions or need support, please contact your building principals and/or administrative team for help.
